Topic: Transport and Travel	Termly Learning Opportunities/Homework Choices			
English, Reading and Writing	Read a story with someone in your family. See if you can answer questions about the story.	Practice writing your name using different things around the house e.g. shaving foam, toys, chalk in the garden, letters on the fridge.	Read a story with someone in your family. See if you can find any rhyming words in the book?	Take a photo or draw a picture of people in your family and add speech bubbles to it. What are your family saying?
Maths & Problem Solving	Count how many cars you see on your way home	Draw a bus with five windows. Draw a car with four wheels. Draw a plane with two wings.	Make a pictogram with some of your favourite toys e.g. teddies, dolls.	Make a tally chart of the different colour cars on your street.
Science and the Outside Environment.	Make a boat out of materials around the home. Does it float or sink?	Take a walk in your local community. What modes of transport can you see? If you live near a river or lake look at the different sorts of boats.	Use things from your garden or your street to create a picture of a car e.g. stones, sticks, leaves.	With help from an adult make and decorate a paper airplane and see how far you can make it fly.
Creative Arts, Design and Cooking	Use playdoh to create a mode of transport e.g. a plane or boat.	Draw or paint a picture of your favourite mode of transport.	Do some junk modelling. Create a car out of bits of recycling.	With adult support make yourself a drink and a snack (e.g. squash and a sandwich). Work towards doing this as independently as possible.
Humanities, PSHE and Citizenship	Play a board game or video game with someone in your family.	Use the internet to look up old modes of transport e.g. penny farthing bike.	Use the internet to look up forms of transport in different countries. Write a sentence about and/or draw a picture of one that you find interesting (e.g. Tuk Tuks in India).	Draw a picture and/or write about your favourite activity you have done at Forest school e.g. watching the campfire, making hot chocolate, toasting marshmallows or playing in the mud area.
