In Topic, Acer Class have been looking at our local area. This week we looked at the school and drew a map of the outside area. We walked around the space to make sure we had recorded everything.

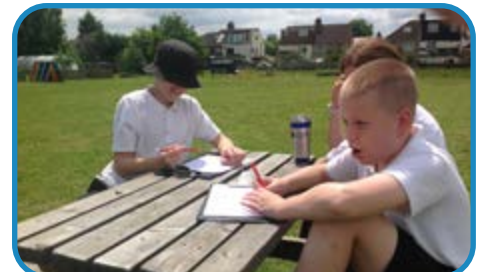
Alex: I had to draw the places outside on the field. I had to draw forest school, the animals and the sensory garden. I found it quite hard because of the heat.
