

Dear Parents/ Carers

We are always proud of how well our pupils are presented but recently have noticed that many of our pupils are not wearing the correct uniform. We have spoken to the pupils and agreed 1 or 2 changes to our uniform policy. **They are highlighted below in blue.**

- ✓ Pupils are expected to wear full school uniform which includes **black trousers**, a **black skirt** or **black shorts**.
- ✓ Pupils can also wear a **plain white or black polo shirt**.
- ✓ They should also have a **plain black school jumper or a plain black fleece or tracksuit top (with no hoodie.)**
- ✓ They should also be wearing **black school shoes** or **plain black trainers**.
- ✓ On days that they have PE or forest school they can **wear PE kit**. This consists of a **plain black tracksuit, white or black t- shirt** (or a **plain yellow, blue, red or green, t-shirt** – depending on their house colour) and plain black trainers.
- ✓ For safety reasons, all long hair must be tied back during Science, Food Tech and P.E. lessons. If pupils are wearing earrings, they should be studs only so that they do not get ripped out accidentally.
- ✓ **Pupils are allowed to wear a small nose stud.**
- ✓ Pupils **must have short nails** and may wear **clear nail varnish or have a French manicure**.
- ✗ Pupils are not allowed to wear leggings.
- ✗ Pupils are not allowed to wear false nails.
- ✗ Pupils are not allowed to wear any jewellery **except for studs**.
- ✗ Pupils should not have any branded items as part of their school uniform.

Please can you ensure that you child wears the correct uniform to school daily. If you feel that your child has any sensory needs or you need any support with uniform, please do not hesitate to get in touch with your child's Form Tutor.
