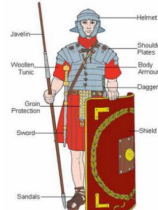
To write a diary entry. This should be done from the perspective of a Roman child.



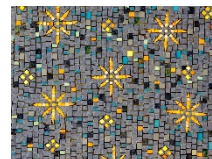
Create an Acrostic Poem. Put ROMANS down the side and then put a different word for each letter.

Maths

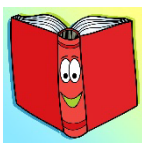
Make a Roman numeral clock.



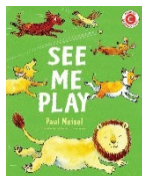
Create Roman coin rubbings. Rub a crayon over the top of money on a bit of paper.

Role plays your favorite scene from a book you like reading.



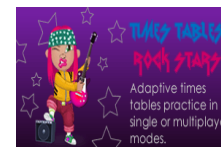
Practise your pronouns. Put them into as many sentences as you can: he, she, his, her.

Go to the shop and use money to buy an item.

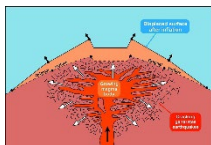


Topic

The secret scent. Put a few different things in a jar and guess what they smell like.



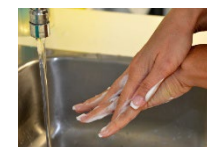
Laundry sorting into colors, whites and darks.



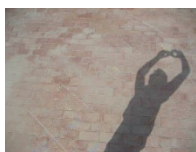
The safety scavenger hunts. Walk around the house and list 3 hot things and 3 cold things.

Be a human sundial. On a sunny day mark where your shadow is at 10, 12 and 2pm.

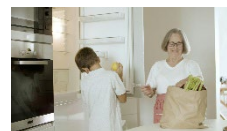


Mosaic art painting. Get a sponge cut into small pieces and make a mosaic using different colored paints.
